## New to Clipper? Here's what to do.

# 1 Get Clipper

Clipper is available as a plastic card or in your phone's mobile wallet. You can order an adult plastic Clipper card at clippercard.com or buy one in person. To get Clipper on your phone, visit clippercard.com/pay-with-phone to learn how to add a card in Apple Pay or Google Pay or transfer an existing card to your phone. New adult cards are \$3. Youth and Senior Clipper cards are always free—visit clippercard.com or call Clipper Customer Service to apply.

## **2** Load Value

Your card can hold transit passes, cash value or any combination. Passes are specific to transit systems. Cash value works on all your transit trips. Load value (and get a card) at:

- Clippercard.com You can load value whenever you want or set up automatic reloading for most convenience
- Self-serve machines at BART (cash value only), Muni, Golden Gate Ferry, SMART and VTA
- Participating retailers such as Walgreens and Whole Foods Market stores
- Staffed locations such as transit agency ticket offices and Clipper Customer Service Centers
- Clipper Customer Service at 877.878.8883
- Your pre-tax transit benefit program
- On your phone directly in Apple Pay or Google Pay (or using the Clipper app)

# **3** Tag Your Card

Tag your card or phone every time you board.

Find the Clipper reader on the bus or at fare gates, train stations and ferry terminals. Hold your card or phone flat against the Clipper logo on the reader and wait for the beep and green light, or the BART fare gate to say "OK".

Remember to tag off. Some agencies charge by the distance you travel, so tag off at the end of your trip on: BART, Caltrain, Golden Gate Transit, Marin Transit, San Francisco Bay Ferry, SMART and Sonoma County Transit.

# 4 Protect and Manage

Register for balance protection and manage your account online or in the Clipper app. You can download the Clipper app from the Apple App Store or the Google Play Store. With the Clipper app, you can manage and load cash value and passes, set up Autoload, register your Clipper card, plan your trips, and more! You can also register your card for free at clippercard.com or by phone.

# CLIPPER TIP!

### **Reload Automatically**

Clipper can automatically reload value to your card whenever your cash value or BART high-value discount balance is below \$10, or your pass expires. Choose Autoload when ordering a plastic card and your card is free. You can set up Autoload for plastic or mobile cards anytime on clippercard.com or using the Clipper app.

## **Discounts with Clipper**
